



Your child has been referred for psychological testing. Our policy is to select tests based upon the specific referring questions; therefore, testing instruments may vary from child to child. If an intake interview has not been conducted by another therapist then the evaluation will begin with an initial intake interview, which costs \$165.00. A \$25.00 fee to cover the administrative costs associated with the processing of your initial paperwork is also required. Our charges for psychological testing are based on an hourly rate of \$150.00 per hour. In addition to direct service provided during the evaluation sessions, testing fees will also include billable hours for review of the patient’s history, analysis of behavioral scales, test scoring, interpretation of data, case consultation and report writing. A report typically goes through 3 revisions to prepare the final document.

Example: A child is seen for two 3-hour test sessions (6 hours x \$150.00 = \$900.00). Scoring, interpretation, and report writing typically require the same amount of time (approximately 6 hours x \$150.00, which equals \$900.00). In this case the testing total is \$1800.00.

A psychological evaluation also requires a feedback session in which your child’s cognitive profile and treatment recommendations are discussed at length. The fee for this session is also \$150.00 per hour, with conferences usually averaging 1½ hours (\$225.00). Therefore, a comprehensive evaluation that begins with an intake interview, followed by one long test session or two partial sessions and a feedback conference could be expected to average \$2215.00. Additional charges typically include a fee for an online computer test of \$15.00 and with adolescents, a mail-in scoring fee of \$35.00 for a personality inventory, (\$2265.00).

Most insurance companies do not cover psychological testing, especially when the referral relates to school and learning problems. As a result, you are responsible for the entire bill. If your child meets criteria for a Specific Learning Disability or Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, Cognitive Disorder, etc., you can submit your own insurance claim with the diagnosis provided to determine if any benefits may exist. Our current policy requires that you pay the entire estimated fees at the time of the intake interview. Your anticipated payments are listed below.
